Our service will start at the grave marker of Heroine Laura Wesson in front of the Confederate Monument and the final resting place of fifty Confederate soldiers representing Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, Louisiana, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia who died while being treated at the Wayside Hospital in High Point during the War Between the States. Many buried at Oakwood Cemetery with families not knowing what happened to them when they never returned home.

This special ceremony will honor the traditions of our forebears by the decorating the graves, laying wreaths, presentation of a Proclamation and a Resolution by distinguished dignitaries and the reading of the names of the soldiers buried all around the City of High Point followed by the Walk of Honor. The Confederate Memorial Honor Guard will fire muskets and the Confederate Memorial Cannon Crew will make some noise as a tribute to the remembrance of our ancestors and Confederate Ancestors.
